Newspaper Container	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Newspaper &amp; inserts</li> </ul>	
Glass Container	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Glass bottles &amp; jars</li> </ul>	Items <b>not acceptable</b> include: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Broken glass</li> <li>Cups, dishes, plates, Pyrex, glass windows, light bulbs, ceramics, mirrors, crystal</li> </ul>
Commingled Containers	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Rigid plastic containers marked with a recycling logo with #1-7</li> <li>Steel, tin &amp; aluminum cans</li> <li>Foil and pie plates</li> <li>Empty steel aerosol cans</li> <li>Milk &amp; juice cartons</li> <li>Juice boxes</li> <li>Cream &amp; creamer containers</li> <li>Rinse out food, labels are OK</li> </ul>	Items <b>not acceptable</b> include: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Cups, dishes, plates, Pyrex, glass windows, light bulbs, ceramics, mirrors, crystal</li> <li>Plastic bags or food wrap</li> <li>Styrofoam or packing materials</li> <li>Automotive fluid bottles</li> <li>Ice cream boxes</li> <li>Margarine or cream cheese boxes</li> <li>Appliances of any kind</li> <li>Take-out trays or meat trays</li> </ul>
