ARTICLE 16C: To see if the Town will vote to transfer from the Community Preservation Fund estimated annual revenues, fund balance, or historic resources reserves, or otherwise fund, a sum of money [the amount of \$67,500.00] for the purposes of the restoration and preservation of the 1749 Spooner House located on North Street pursuant to a grant agreement between the Town and the Plymouth Antiquarian Society outlining the purposes and conditions upon which the funds may be expended, and to authorize the Board of Selectmen to enter into such grant agreement and to authorize the Board of Selectmen or its designees to accept one or more deed restrictions on said property meeting the requirements of G.L. c.184, §31, or take any other action relative thereto.

COMMUNITY PRESERVATION COMMITTEE

RECOMMENDATION: Approval \$67,500 (Unanimous). The Advisory and Finance Committee advises Town Meeting to approve Article 16C. Approval of this article will authorize the use of CPC funds for the restoration and preservation of the 1749 Spooner House on North Street. Town would receive an Historic Preservation Restriction on the 1749 Spooner House Museum, which is currently an unprotected piece of property.
