

CREMATORIAL INFORMATION

Vine Hills Crematory has served much of eastern Massachusetts, including Cape Cod, since it opened in 2009. The facility is professionally managed by Town of Plymouth employees who are certified by CANA – the Cremation Association of North America.

The choice of cremation or full burial is a personal one. If you decide on cremation at Vine Hills, be sure to inform your funeral director in advance so arrangements may be made.

CEMETERY INFORMATION



Lots for full burials and cremations are available at Vine Hills Cemetery with limited space at other cemeteries. Both residents and non-residents may purchase lots, although the cost does differ.

All Plymouth cemeteries welcome visitors year round and are open dawn to dusk. We remind you that these are places of rest. Many of the earliest settlers to America are at peace here. 
