Work at: 6 Lincoln St. (Nathaniel Morton)	82,540.00

Description: The main scope of this particular job entails two of the larger rooms in the school, the IMC and the Gym. Due to water damage, there is significant failure to large portions of the IMC walls and much of the ceiling. The gym is primarily limited to the older brick which is currently painted.

Note: This estimate is predicated on the town providing all necessary lifts to accomplish the below scope of work

Scope:

A. Gymnasium: Prep and paint upper portions of currently painted brick (all portions above the lower unpainted tiles)  
-We will remove all loose coatings via manual scraping, wire brushing, and possibly light sanding in spots. All debris will be collected and removed.

Note: There is a portion of fairly significant water damage to one section

-We will apply a bonding primer as needed to portions of damaged brick

-We will apply two coats of an interior acrylic latex coating appropriate for masonry (match color)

-We will apply two coats to all secondary structure that fall within the field of brick to be painted. This will include but is not limited to the following: cast iron radiators, metal hand rail sections at front of gym, room divider, piping, wooden portions of trim above the room divider, etc.

EXCLUSIONS:

-No work to any portions of the ceiling (acoustic tiling)

-No work to any portions of stained/poly trim or doors

-No work to any of the perimeter closets/rooms

B. IMC (Library): Prep and paint water damaged walls and ceiling in full -We will remove the failed coatings and plaster from the areas of water damaged walls -We will skim coat these areas with new plaster and blend as best we can with the surrounding portions of the walls that are still sound and intact -We will repair any defects in the ceiling and remove any failed coatings -Spot-priming will be done as needed throughout -We will apply two coats of ceiling paint to the entire ceiling (touching up random portions only will not make the ceiling look any better than it currently does -We will apply two coats of finish paint to the portions of walls that we repair (match color) Note: All portions of detailed plaster/masonry such as the crests above each window will be carefully dealt with and will be retained as they are now with proper color matching *Above scope includes all labor, materials, and insurance to complete as outlined*	<del>\$146,300.00</del> \$85,320.00

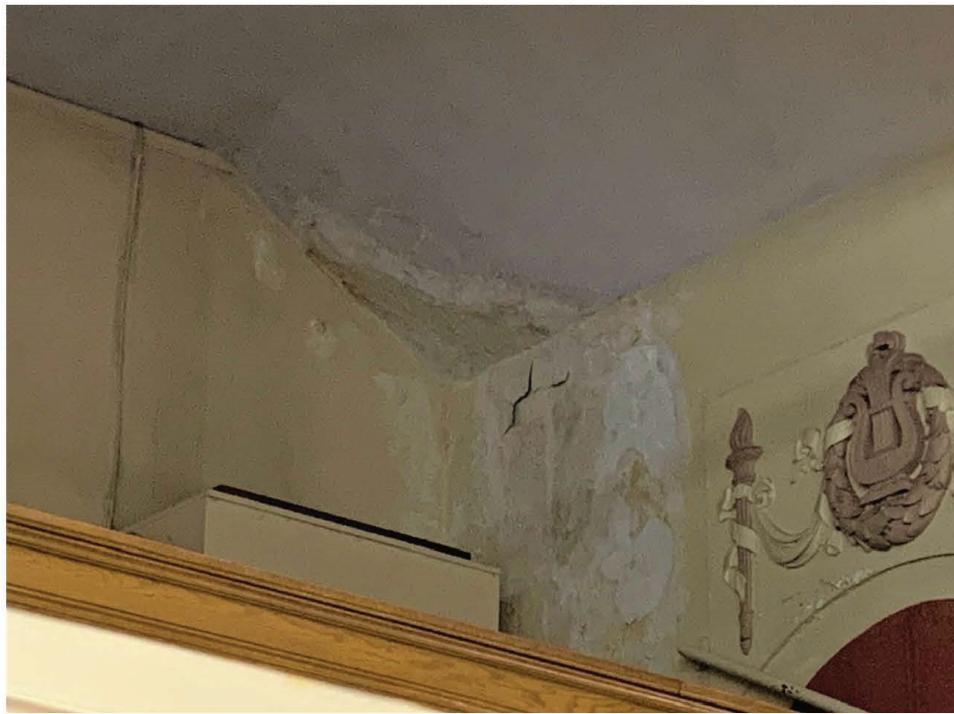
\*\$4,680/day for labor (3 painters standard), all materials needed will be added to the cost
