Criteria for Snow Plowing Services on Unaccepted Ways

1. All roads shall have a travel way at least sixteen (16') feet wide and of adequate surface, construction and grade with brush and trees cut back at least five feet from each edge of the traveled surface. A minimum canopy height of sixteen (16') feet is required for the entire length of the roadway.
2. Roads shall have a minimum four (4') foot shoulder for snow removal and storage.
3. Roads shall have sufficient turn-around area or two separate entrances.
4. Roads shall be connected to an existing plow route.
5. Roads shall have adequate drainage.
6. The existence of any current Homeowners Associations and their responsibilities for roadway plowing and maintenance; any current maintenance agreements as well as a list of any construction waivers/variances granted by Town boards, covenants or individual homeowner easements shall be supplied to the committee with the snow plow form.
7. "Private" or "Gated" communities or named driveways will not be considered.
8. Roadway inspections may be conducted prior to start of plowing services and as long as the roadway remains on the plowing list. Should roadway conditions fall below the DPW criteria, plowing services will be suspended until any required improvements have been made and approved.
9. Snow plow requests may be submitted no sooner than three years following a rejected application unless significant improvements have been made to the elements of the previous denial.
