PLYMOUTH POLICE CONFIRM BRIEF ALTERCATION LED TO PLYMOUTH NORTH STAY IN PLACE ORDER, NO THREAT FOUND

PLYMOUTH, MA – On the afternoon of Thursday, April 17, 2025, Plymouth North High School was placed under a stay-in-place order. Upon arrival and investigation by the Plymouth Police Department, the incident was determined to be an altercation and misunderstanding between two students.

After confirming there was no imminent or ongoing threat to students or staff, the stay-in-place order was lifted.

While various rumors have circulated on social media, Plymouth Police have confirmed that the situation was a brief dispute that was quickly resolved.
