## **Advisory: Plymouth**

### **Bridge Repairs on Jordan Road over Route 3**

*Overnight Hours between 9 p.m. and 5 a.m.*

*Sunday, August 17, Monday, August 18, and Tuesday, August 19*

**PLYMOUTH** - The Massachusetts Department of Transportation (MassDOT) is announcing crews will be performing bridge repairs on Jordan Road over Route 3 northbound and southbound in Plymouth. The work is scheduled to take place nightly, Sunday through Tuesday between 9:00 p.m. and 5:00 a.m., starting Sunday night, August 17, Monday night, August 18, and Tuesday night, August 19. The work is anticipated to be completed by Wednesday morning, August 20.

Lane closures on Route 3 northbound and southbound will be in place. Temporary traffic alterations, including lane and shoulder closures, will occur as needed. At least one lane of travel will be maintained, and police will assist with traffic control and safety setups.

Appropriate signage and messaging will be in place to guide drivers through the work area.

Drivers traveling through the affected area should expect delays, reduce speed, and use caution.

All scheduled work is weather dependent and subject to change without notice.
