Bridge Repairs on Jordan Road over Route 3

Nightly - Sunday, September 7, through Thursday, October 30, 9:00 p.m. to 5:00 a.m. the following morning

PLYMOUTH - The Massachusetts Department of Transportation (MassDOT) is announcing that it will be performing bridge repairs on Jordan Road over Route 3 northbound and southbound in Plymouth. The work is scheduled to take place nightly, Sunday through Thursday, between 9:00 p.m. and 5:00 a.m. the following morning, starting Sunday, September 7, through Thursday, October 30. The work is anticipated to be completed by Friday morning, October 31.

Lane closures on Route 3 northbound and southbound will be in place. Temporary traffic alterations, including lane and shoulder closures, will occur as needed. At least one lane of travel will be maintained at all times, and police will assist with traffic control and safety setups.

Appropriate signage and messaging will be in place to guide drivers through the work area.

Drivers traveling through the affected area should expect delays, reduce speed, and use caution.

All scheduled work is weather dependent and subject to change without notice.
