

Two Coordinators (optimal)

Locks for the gates and shed

Assemble Outdoor tables & move products to display

Evaluate, label, and organize products

Two Drop Off Volunteers (minimum)

Volunteers to Walk the Floor

Help “customers” and direct them alternative resources



Commitment



- Volunteer one shift a month
- Shifts are Saturday mornings 8:30am-12:30pm
- May thru October
- Volunteers will work together to:
 - Open the shop and set up for the day
 - Evaluate, label and organize products
 - Maintain the area
 - Help "customers"
 - Close the shop

Property Tax Work Off Program Eligibility

- Selected by lottery
- Must be:
 - At least age 60 by January 1, 2026, or
 - A Veteran as defined by MGL C.4, Section 7, Clause 43, or
 - A spouse may be an “Approved Representative” of a disabled Veteran to do the work
- Must be a homeowner listed on the deed as the year - round resident (no trusts)
- Must occupy the property for which the taxes are paid
- Must be in good standing with all taxes, Utilities and Excise taxes
