## UPDATE - GATRA DRIVER STRIKE CONTINUED TUESDAY, SEPT. 30TH

**FOR IMMEDIATE RELEASE: 9/30/2025**

**PLYMOUTH, MA** – The Greater Attleboro Taunton Regional Transit Authority (GATRA) announced this morning that the driver strike is still in effect as of Tuesday, September 30, 2025, and will cause service disruptions, including in Plymouth.

**There will be limited service on Fixed Routes, ADA Paratransit, and Dial-A-Ride services run by operations out of GATRA's Taunton and Wareham offices. If a resident's scheduled Dial-A-Ride or ADA Paratransit trip has been cancelled, he/she should receive a cancellation notice directly from GATRA.**

**ALL Taunton/Attleboro and Wareham/Plymouth Fixed Routes will be operating with the exception of the following:**

- Freedom Link
- Wareham-New Bedford Connection
- Wareham-Plymouth Connection **will run on a REDUCED SCHEDULE.**

GATRA will continue to prioritize life-sustaining medical transportation. Dial-A-Ride and ADA Paratransit services are operating at almost normal levels. Most trips scheduled for Tuesday will operate as normal.

GATRA GO Coastline will be available on a limited basis. **App booking remains suspended. Call the office to book a trip.**

### **The following GATRA services will NOT be affected:**

- GATRA's PT-1 transportation and other transportation provided by GATRA through contracts with the state will be booked and taken as normal.
- GATRA GO United, Explore, and Seacoast will run as normal.

- Dial-A-Ride service run by Councils on Aging (COAs) will run as normal.
- Long distance medical transportation programs will run as normal.
- Medway T Shuttle, Middleborough Downtown Shuttle, and Gateway Link.
