Wrong Way Vehicle Detection System Maintenance at Route 3 Exit 13

Thursday, October 23, 9:00 p.m. to 12:00 a.m.

PLYMOUTH, MA - The Massachusetts Department of Transportation (MassDOT) is announcing that it will be performing maintenance on the Wrong Way Vehicle Detection System on Route 3 northbound and southbound at exit ramp 13. **The work is scheduled for Thursday, October 23, from 9:00 p.m. until 12:00 a.m.**

Lane closures on Route 3, exit 13 northbound and southbound, will be in place. Temporary traffic alterations, including lane and shoulder closures, will occur as needed. At least one lane of travel will be maintained at all times, and police will assist with traffic control and safety setups.

Appropriate signage and messaging will be in place to guide drivers through the work area.

Drivers traveling through the affected area should expect delays, reduce speed, and use caution.

All scheduled work is weather dependent and subject to change without notice.
