CONSTRUCTION NOTICE

TO: Area Residents
FROM: Town of Plymouth – Department of Public Works (DPW)
RE: Roadway Re-Surfacing Project
DATE: October 23, 2025

The Town of Plymouth is pleased to announce the Roadway Re-Surfacing Project for **Manomet Avenue (Vinal Avenue to Old Beach Road), Old Beach Road, Simes Road and Holmes Road (Simes Road to Strand Avenue)**. This work is expected to start on **Monday, October 27th**.

Barring any inclement weather and unforeseen circumstances, work is expected to occur between the hours of 7:00 AM to 4:30 PM, Monday through Friday. We anticipate this work will take approximately **six to eight (6 to 8) weeks** to complete.

The work will consist of roadway reclamation (grinding of existing paved surface) and re-paving the roadways. This construction season, the DPW will be placing the first new course of asphalt “binder course.” Next year’s construction season, we anticipate performing any drainage work/repairs and placing the final “top course” of asphalt. Our contractor plans to start with Manomet Avenue and Old Beach Road.

Before the start of construction, traffic barrels and signage will be in place to alert motorists and pedestrians of the construction. Residents may expect temporary parking restrictions, minor traffic delays, and possible daytime detours. We ask that you drive carefully and be alert to activity in the area.

We are asking that residents do not park their cars on the street within the work zone during the hours of 7:00 AM to 4:30 PM. Access to individual driveways should remain accessible, except when specifically working around your driveway. We ask that you look for alternative parking during those days and the contractor will coordinate with you for that work.

The Town of Plymouth and our contractor, Pawtucket Hot Mix Asphalt, Inc. will make every effort to minimize inconveniences to residents and visitors in the area. However, due to the inherent nature of construction, some level of disruption may occur. Your cooperation with this important public works project is greatly appreciated.
