## **Advisory: Plymouth**

### **Update: Bridge Repairs on Jordan Road over Route 3**

*Nightly – Tuesday, November 4, through Thursday, November 6, 9:00 p.m to 5:00 a.m. the following morning*

**PLYMOUTH** - The Massachusetts Department of Transportation (MassDOT) has announced the contractor has resumed work on the Plymouth Bridge at Jordan Road over Route 3 for bridge deck demolition and lagging installation. Work will take place **nightly from Tuesday, November 4, through Thursday, November 6, between 9:00 PM and 5:00 AM.**

*Single-lane closures will be in effect, with at least one lane of travel open at all times.* The work is anticipated to be completed by Thursday morning, November 6.

Appropriate signage and messaging will be in place to guide drivers through the work area.

Drivers traveling through the affected area should expect delays, reduce speed, and use caution.

All scheduled work is weather dependent and subject to change without notice.
