PLYMOUTH AWARDED \$1.5 MILLION GRANT FOR TOWN WHARF REPAIRS & IMPROVEMENTS

PLYMOUTH, MA – The Town of Plymouth Harbormaster, in partnership with Plymouth’s Department of Energy and Environment (DEE), has been awarded \$1,500,000 from the Massachusetts Seaport Economic Council (SEC) to support critical repairs and infrastructure improvements at Town Wharf.

The Massachusetts SEC, operating under the Massachusetts Executive Office of Economic Development, works to strengthen the Commonwealth’s maritime economy by promoting economic development and investing in resilient coastal infrastructure across all 78 coastal communities. Through its annual grant program, the SEC supports community planning and capital investment projects that enhance maritime assets while preparing communities for sea level rise and increasingly severe coastal storms.

Funding awarded to Plymouth will support the second phase of repairs to Town Wharf, as well as the remaining final design costs for improvements to the seawall and pedestrian walkways along Town Wharf’s roadway. These improvements will enhance safety, strengthen coastal resilience, and preserve a critical hub of Plymouth’s working waterfront.

“This funding is a significant investment in Plymouth’s maritime economy and our ability to adapt to the challenges facing coastal communities,” **said Plymouth Town Manager Derek Brindisi**. “Town Wharf is essential to local commerce, tourism, and public access to our harbor. By strengthening this infrastructure now, we are protecting jobs, supporting economic activity, and ensuring our waterfront remains resilient and accessible for years to come.”
