FROM: Town of Plymouth – Department of Public Works (DPW)
RE: Fremont Street – Proposed One-Way Traffic Flow
DATE: December 31, 2025

The Town of Plymouth implemented a “pilot” one-way traffic pattern on Fremont Street on December 8, 2025. Since that time, vehicle travel has only been allowed in the eastbound direction, from Sandwich Street towards Union Street. This change was a result of a resident petition and the Plymouth Center & North Plymouth Circulation & Mobility Study.

The DPW is requesting feedback from area residents now that the one-way traffic pattern has been in place for about thirty (30) days.

The DPW will be holding a public meeting to discuss the one-way traffic pattern and collect additional feedback. Staff will be there to take your comments. The meeting is scheduled for:
